IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

- Registration fee for all classes is \$40. Scholarships are available to students in need.
- **The deadline for registration is 1/29.** Registration will be confirmed by e-mail, unless otherwise requested, by 2/9.

Class sizes are limited. Registrations will be processed by an early registration lottery system. Registrations received by the end of school on **Friday, January 22nd** will be processed by lottery for any classes for which the number of registrations exceeds class capacity. Registration forms will be collected from the Main Office promptly at 3:10 that day. For all other classes, registrations will be processed as they are received until classes are full.

To maximize your child's chance of being placed into his/her first choice class, please rank class choices by preference, and make sure the form has been turned in to the main office by the end of the school day, Friday, January 22nd. If a lottery is required for a given class, we will first process forms for children who have ranked the class #1 or chosen only that class.

- Registration forms may be turned in to your child's teacher, or, **to ensure prompt receipt, brought to the Main Office.**
- Payment for all classes is required at the time of registration. If a class request cannot be fulfilled, payment adjustments will be made.
- Supervision is NOT available after dismissal. Children should be picked up in the main entrance foyer at 4:30.
- Parents may wish to provide an extra after-school snack for their child.
- In case of emergency, leave a message with Nancy Caruso (x224) in the Main Office **before** dismissal. The office closes promptly at 4:30.
